Pastor's 2 Cents From: Fr. Jim DeBruycker

I just binge watched the last episodes of West World on HBO - somebody please explain it to me! I'm starting to bond with my snow blower and I'm still getting hate e-mails from the homophobes of the world. Now, somebody has resurrected the old e-mails about the Heart of the Beast Palm Sunday play - **Puppet Mass Sacrilege at St. Joan of Arc**. Even Archbishop Nienstadt realized it wasn't what they made it out to be. Family is keeping sharp objects away from me.

On the bright side the past weeks controversy has brought some very encouraging and supportive letters. I would like to quote from one because it is a real compliment to the community.

.....I had heard about St. Joan of Arc from a friend that had recently moved and was attending a variety of churches to find a new parish. His message to me was that they were socially aware and the services made him think seriously about if he was doing enough in his daily life to practice his faith. My girls need to know that faith is not just about "you" but the world and how we as Christians need to help each other. So off we went.....

The first thing I noticed was that the parish members were greeting each with hugs. There was a strong sense of family. The testimonial was different but I thought touching. Yes, some of the items on IVF were controversial but that is not a topic unique to homosexual couples given fertilization challenges for many families. The true focus of the conversation was faith, community and love. There was a very serious tone regarding the challenges of our world and a call to action to step in and make a difference....

Maybe you blushed a little, bit but I believe it is true .Our readings today are Luke's version of the beatitudes. To be frank, I prefer Matthew's, but in both cases they are a challenge...and a promise. The promise is they will come about, but we have to work with God to make them happen.

Just a note about the Annual Services Appeal: By now you should have received a letter asking for your support. Please give this your fullest attention and consider pledging. The Services Appeal helps to support the Archdiocese's outreach in many different ways, from the salaries of institutional chaplains to Catholic Charities. 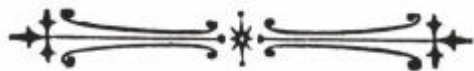
