Pastor's 2 Cents From: Steve Friedrichs SJA Facilities and Operations Director

I'm almost afraid to jinx our current nice weather, but I want to start this "guest column" by thanking our SJA maintenance staff for their efforts the last 4 months. They really put in long hours and unbelievable work to keep our campus open for the hearty souls who braved the weather. However, I know that if we have one more snowfall, they will all call in "sick".

We are grateful for the good news that our roofs held up great during the spring thaw! The new Thermoplastic gym and Parish Center roofs performed well. We're fortunate that all of our roofs held up so we had no leaking on campus at all! Given some of the horror stories we've heard from others, we are saying prayers of gratitude.

You may be aware that SJA has the good fortune to have a dedicated and talented SJA Facilities Committee that has guided us through five years of campus improvement projects. They have held countless early morning meetings to review, evaluate, and oversee projects that have upgraded and expanded our campus facilities. Our SJA staff, ministries and community – from the children in our nursery to our seniors – are benefitting from the dedication of this committee.

Some of their work is easily seen with the addition of the Welcome Center, the restoration of our church, installation of sound panels in the gym for an improved listening environment, and the remodeling of The Arc, which created space for our youth group and ministry meetings during the week.

They also dealt with improvements which are not easily seen but are just as critical for the future of our campus. We installed four new efficient boilers on campus, insuring that we have back-up boilers to heat the Parish Center and school in case of emergency. Then there is the new air conditioning in the gym to create a nice comfort level during summer.

In my role on staff, I'm especially thankful for the Facilities Committee, and grateful and proud to be a part of their work. After thoughtful conversations, research, and debate, they have given SJA and me great direction. They meet at 7:30am every other Wednesday and they work! SJA is blessed to have this very talented group of devoted parishioners, chaired by Jerry Hartlaub.

Finally, all these projects and improvements came about because of the unfailing generosity of the SJA community. Our recent Capitol Campaign provided the funds and the volunteer hours of passionate work to ensure that our great campus will be here for many years to come.
